**Declaration of REACH compliance for products containing lead
(e.g. brass locks, cylinders, keys etc.)**

The company C.Ed. Schulte GmbH Zylinderschlossfabrik (CES), including its group companies (CESfrance SARL, CESnederland B.V. and CESrom S.R.L.), supplies products made of copper and copper alloys that contain small quantities of lead.

This means that CES is a "downstream user" of these materials, as defined in REACH.

The use of these materials in the manufacture of CES products was taken into account during registration.

The products made out of alloys containing lead (lead content > 0.1% w/w) contain the following substances identified as SVHC (Substances of Very High Concern) in concentrations higher than 0.1% (w/w):

Lead	CAS: 7439-92-1 EINECS: 231-100-4	SVHC	27/06/2018	The inclusion of lead as an SVHC in the candidate list triggers information obligations in the supply chain. The hazardous classification and the rules on the safe handling of lead, copper containing lead, and copper alloys containing lead remain unchanged.

The packaging does not contain any of the substances (SVHC) listed in the updated candidate list as at the date of this declaration in concentrations of more than 0.1% (w/w).

Copper and copper alloys are not covered by CLP/GHS rules and are therefore not subject to compulsory labelling or classification requirements.

According to Article 31 of REACH, a REACH safety data sheet (SDS) is not required for copper/copper alloy products.
